3.1 This Agreement commences on the Execution Date, save that in relation to the New National Park Area the Agreement commences upon dedication of the New National Park Area as National Park.

3.2 Subject to clauses 3.3 to 3.7, this Agreement will continue in force in perpetuity.

3.3 Subject to clause 3.4, this Agreement may be terminated by written agreement executed by the Parties.

3.4 The Parties acknowledge that on and from the date the PBC becomes the RNTBC for the Determination, under the PBC Regulations, the BAC will have the function of managing the Native Title Rights and Interests of the Birriah People, and the power to enter into agreements to perform that function, and that as a result this Agreement may be terminated by written agreement executed by the BAC and the State.
